**Day 5: Bryce Canyon National Park - Zion Canyon National Park - Las Vegas** - This morning tour **Bryce Canyon National Park** featuring thousands of delicately carved, brilliantly colored spires rising from amphitheaters. Later travel to **Zion Canyon National Park**, one of the oldest & most scenic

National Parks in the United States.
