- 7:30 -8:30 AM Approximate time to depart depending upon pickup location. Final itinerary with exact pickup times and locations will be sent to you approximately 30 days prior to trip departure.
- 11:00 AM Drop off passengers that want to go to Greektown casino for 5 hours of gaming and lunch on their own. They will receive \$20 in cash play from the casino

- 3:15 PM Depart Edsel Ford home
- 4:00 PM Pick up passengers from Greektown Casino
- 4:30 PM Check into Comfort Inn at Greenfield Village. Dinner on your own at nearby restaurants or at Greenfield Village during the Salute to America Celebration.
- 6:00 PM Depart hotel for Salute to America Celebration at Greenfield Village. *This historic district is transformed into a sea of red, white and blue as the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and many other musical acts presents an evening of music under the stars. Bring a picnic or dine on midsummer favorites from The Henry Ford's award-winning chefs. An entire Fourth of July program of musical Americana, topped off with Tchaikovsky's awe-inspiring 1812 Overture and a lavish fireworks finale. Make sure you bring a folding chair or blanket to sit on.*

- 9:10 AM Depart hotel for Henry Ford Museum and Titanic Exhibit.
On April 15, 1912, Titanic, the world's largest ship, sank after colliding with an iceberg, claiming more than 1,500 lives. During the 100th anniversary of the sinking, The Henry Ford will host the largest touring Exhibition of Titanic: The Artifact Exhibition. This Exhibition, 10,000 square feet in size, features more than 300 artifacts – 250 of which have never been displayed in Michigan. In addition, visitors will walk through extensive room re-creations, be able to get their photos taken near the full-scale replica of the Grand Staircase, as well as learn about passengers on board who had local ties to Michigan. Moving through this newly redesigned and expanded Exhibition, visitors will be taken back in time to 1912 and "travel" through the life of the Titanic — from the ship's construction, to its on-board passengers, its ill-fated voyage, to the amazing artifact rescue efforts that involved divers returning to the sunken ship in recent years.
- Lunch on your own at the Henry Ford Museum
- 2:15 PM Depart Henry Ford Museum for tour of the truck plant. *Ford Rouge Factory Tour is a self-guided five-part experience that includes: Legacy Theater, Art of Manufacturing Theater, Observation Deck, Dearborn Truck Plant and the Legacy Gallery. **Legacy Theatre** highlights the triumphs and tragedies surrounding the Rouge, much of it told through rare, never-before-seen historic footage. **Art of Manufacturing Theatre** is a multi-sensory theater experience including a 360-degree look at how automobiles are made! **Observation Deck & Assembly Plant Walking Tour** allows you to see where the Ford F-150s are assembled in a new lean and flexible manufacturing plant. Visitors will have the opportunity to view the final assembly process from an elevated walkway. **Legacy Gallery** has five historic vehicles made at the Rouge including the 20,000,000th Ford and the Factory Store.*
